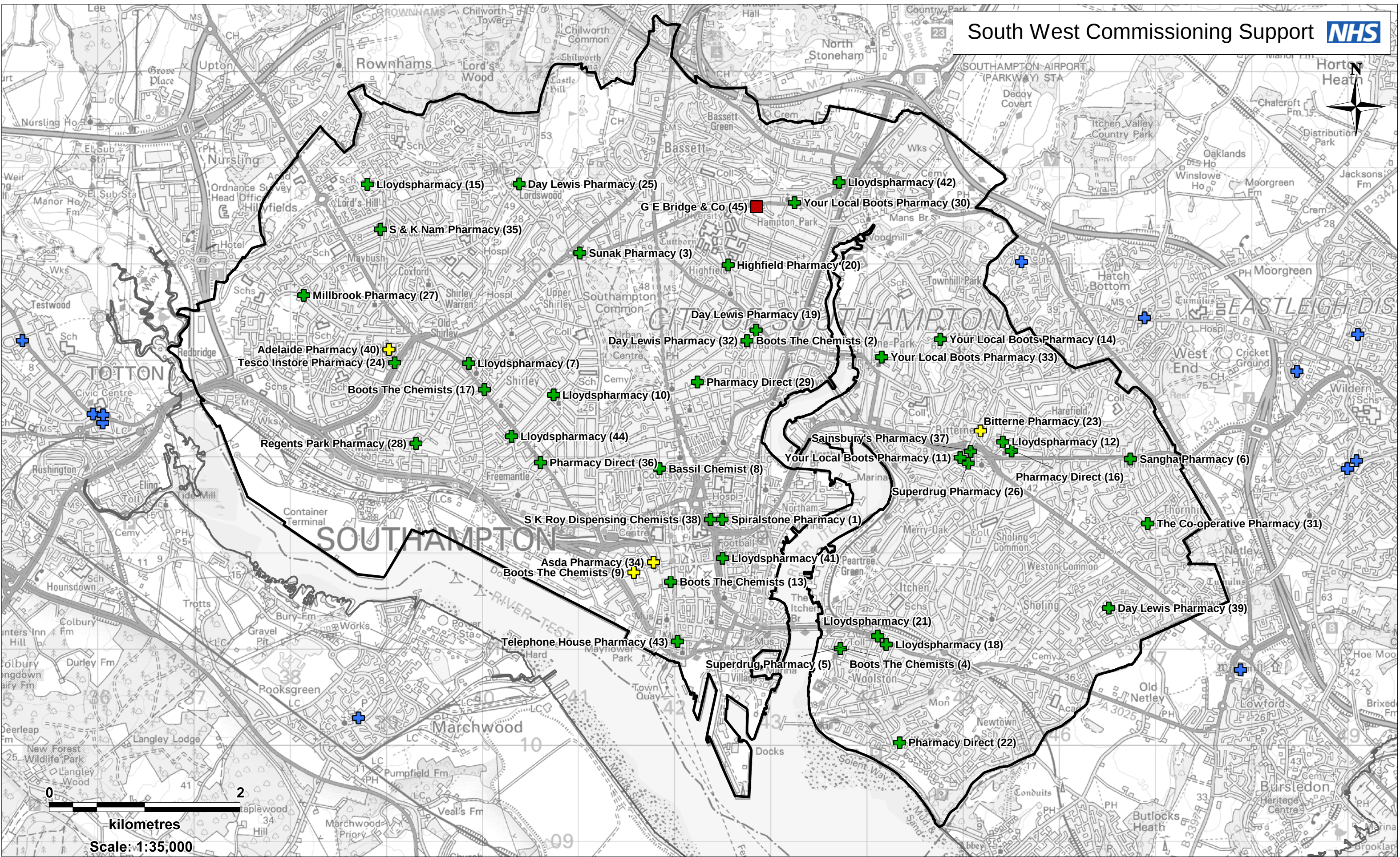

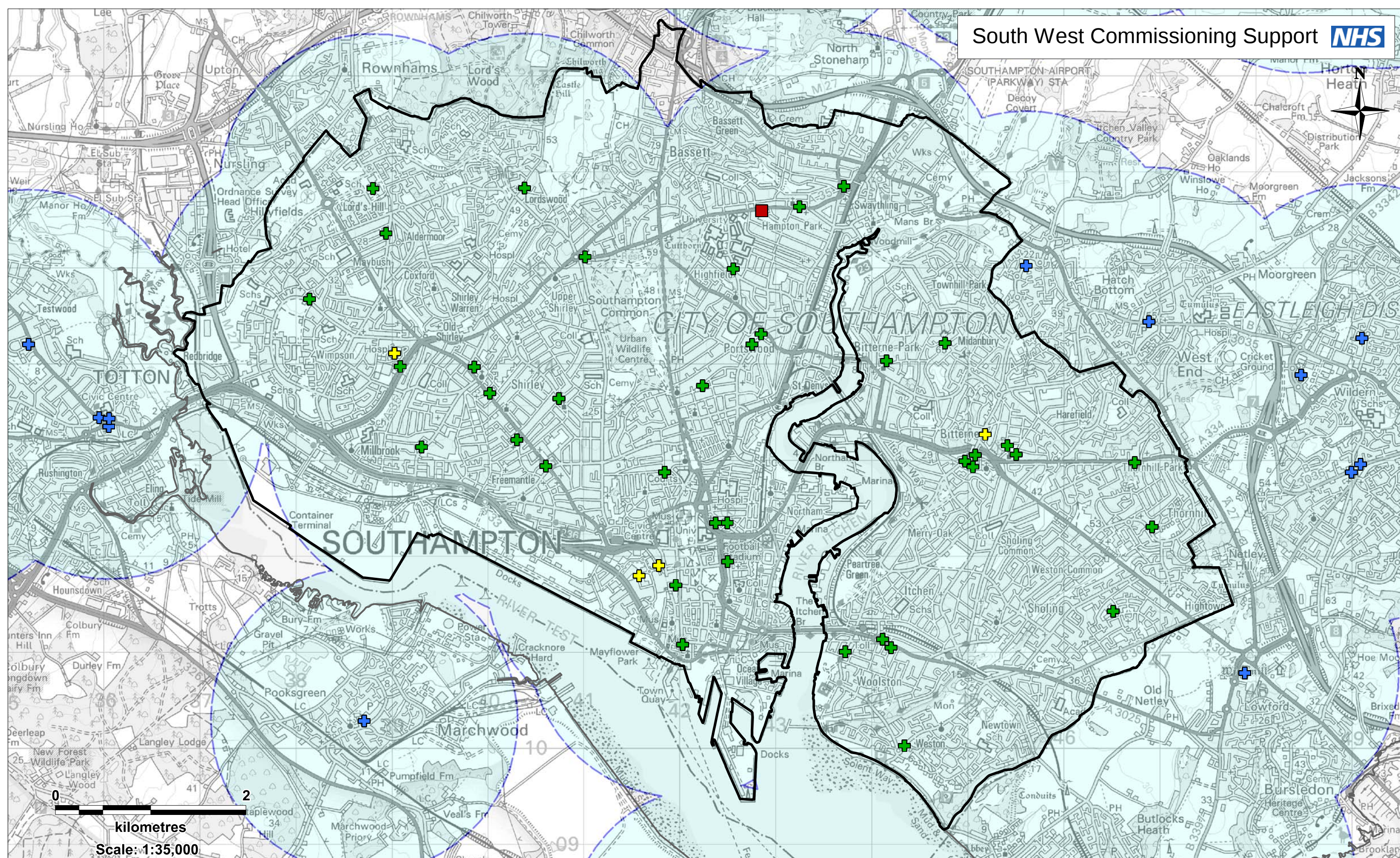

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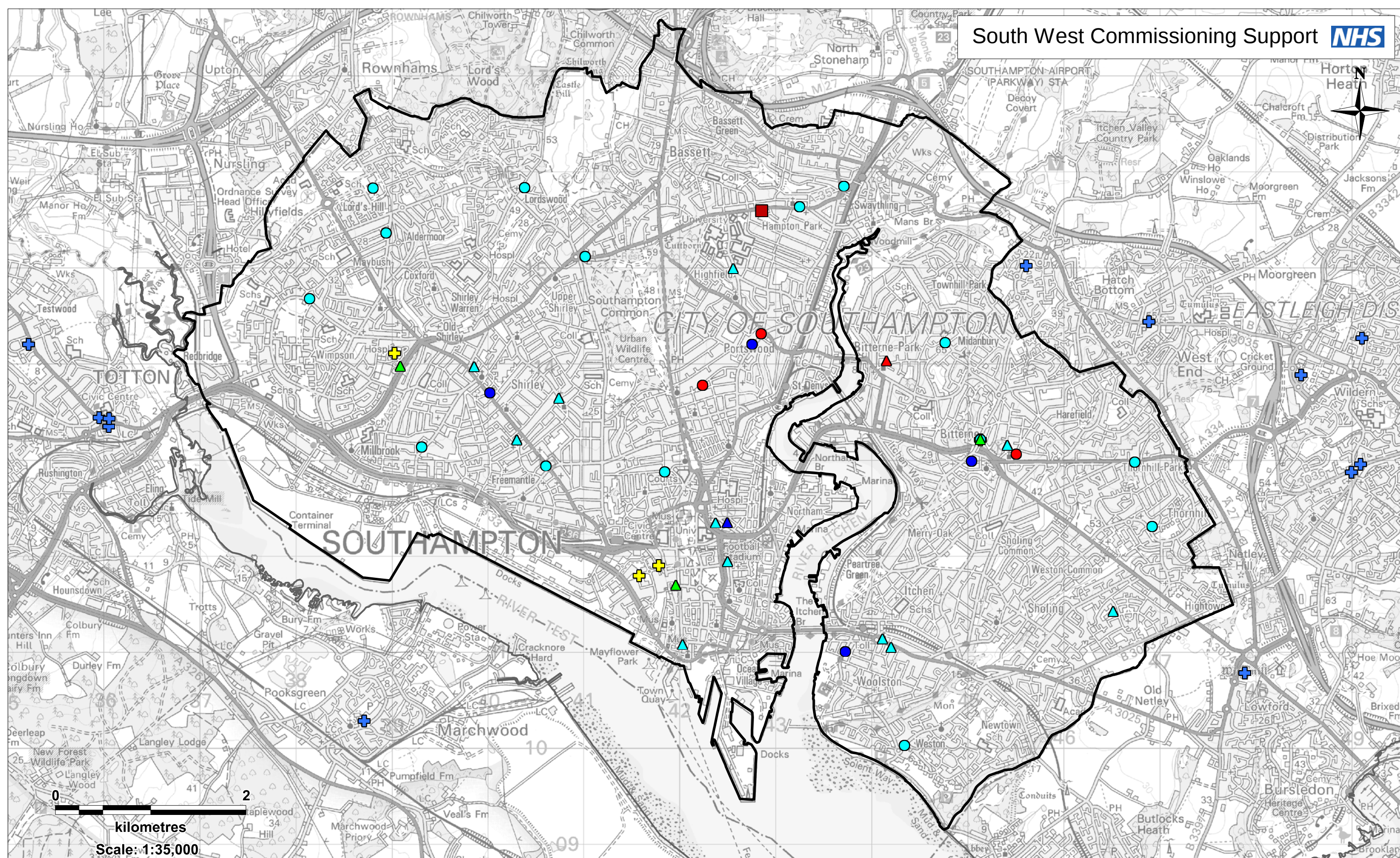

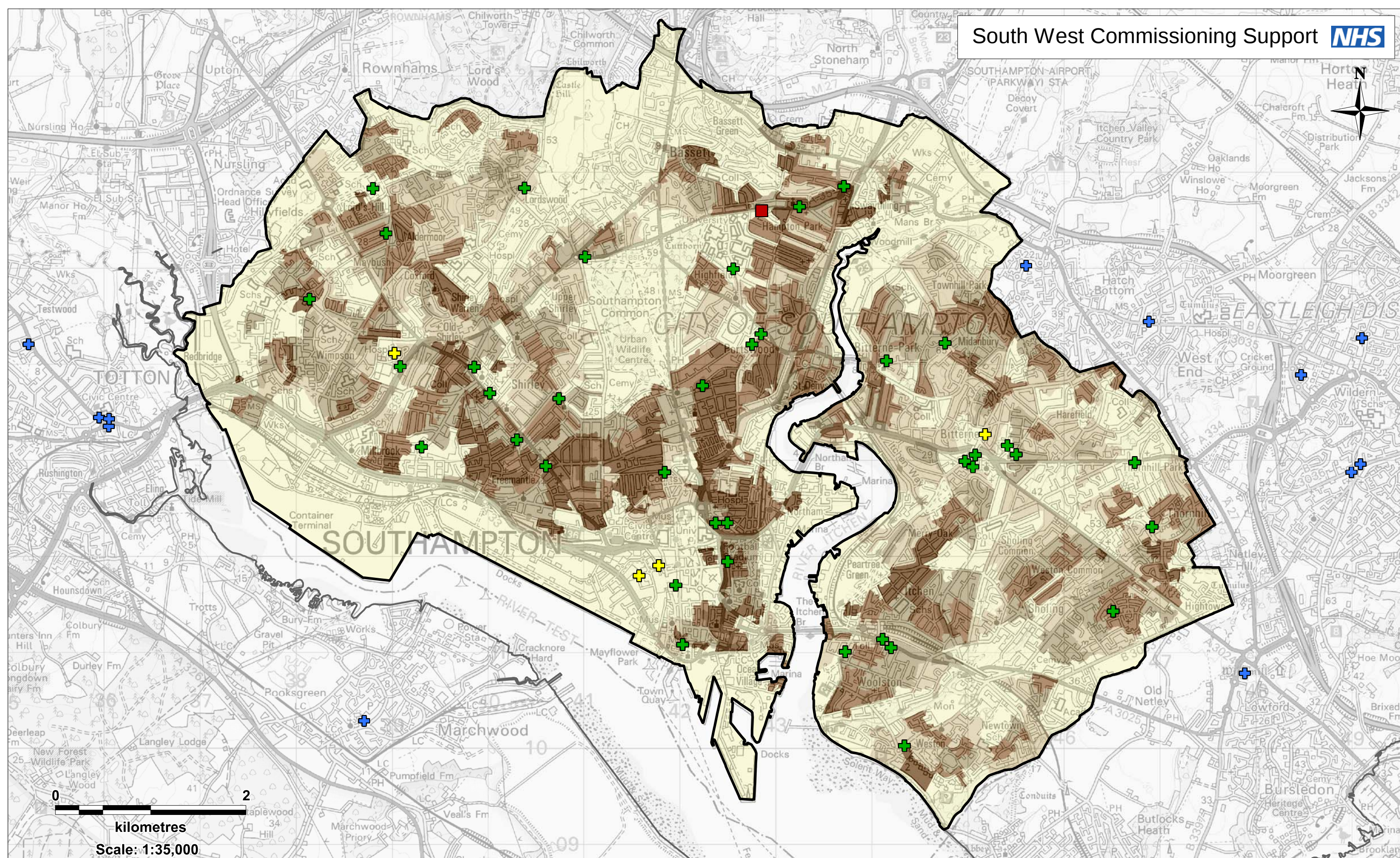

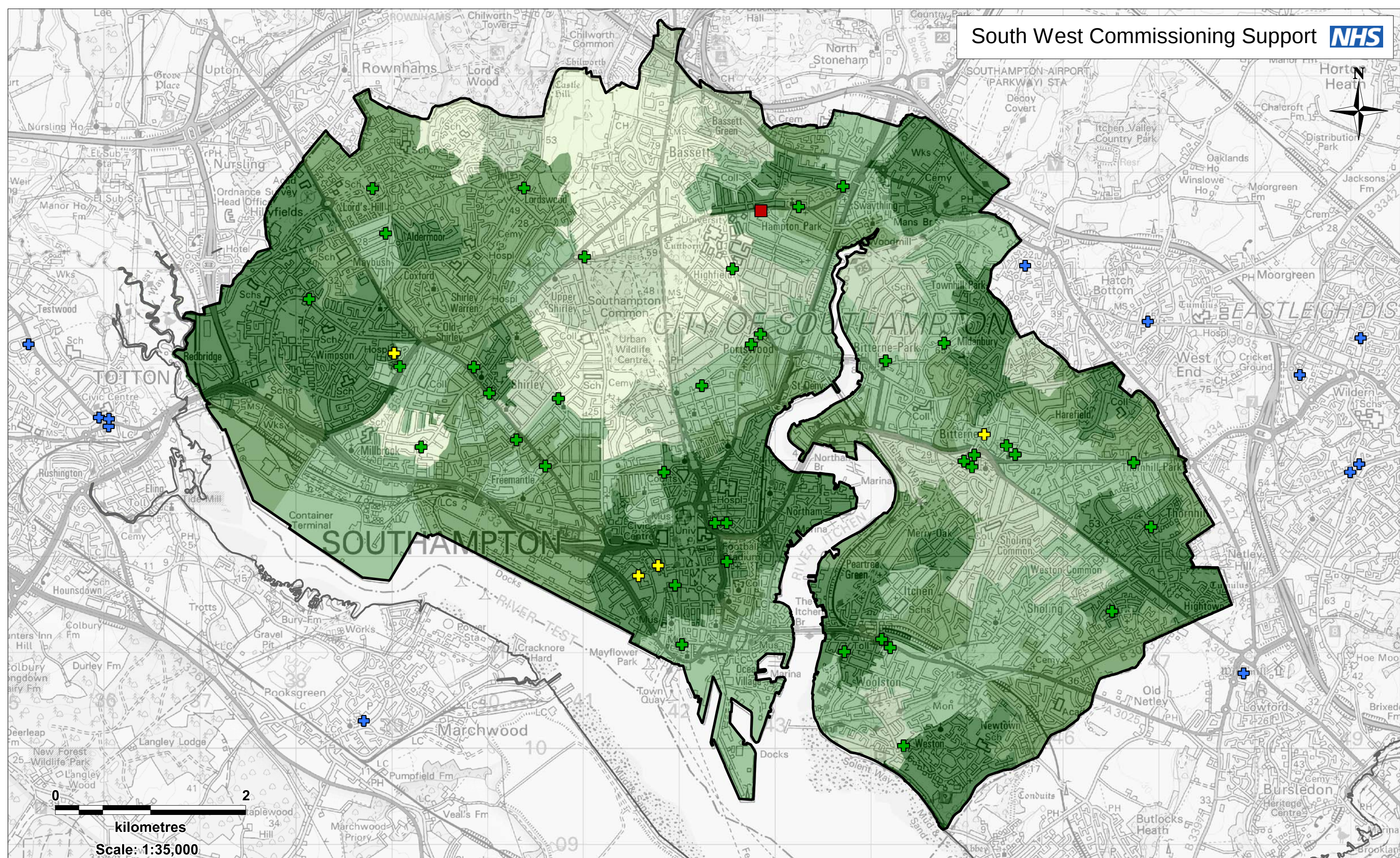

Southampton: Pharmacies and Index of Multiple Deprivation by Lower Super Output Area - Map 5

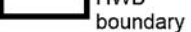

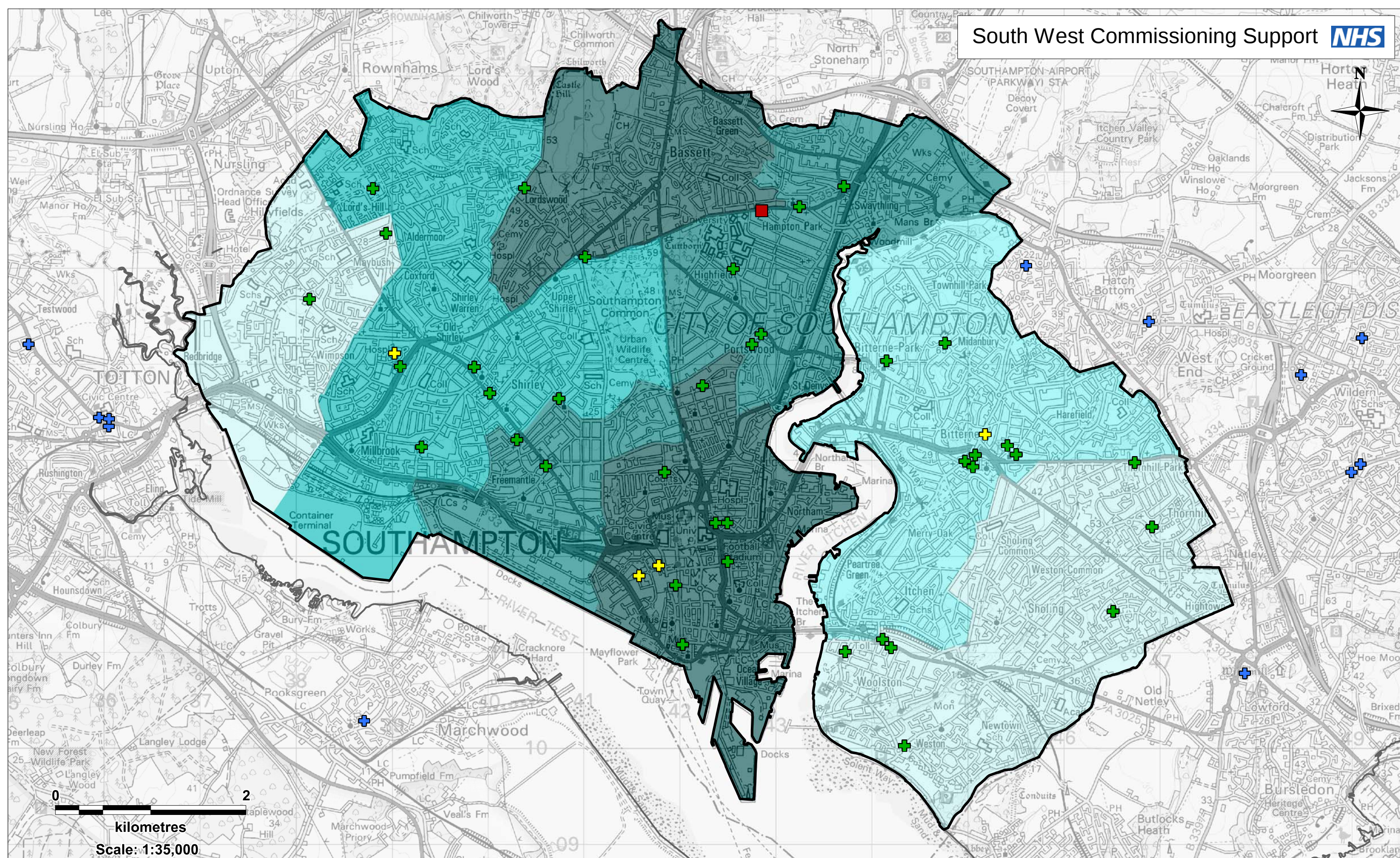

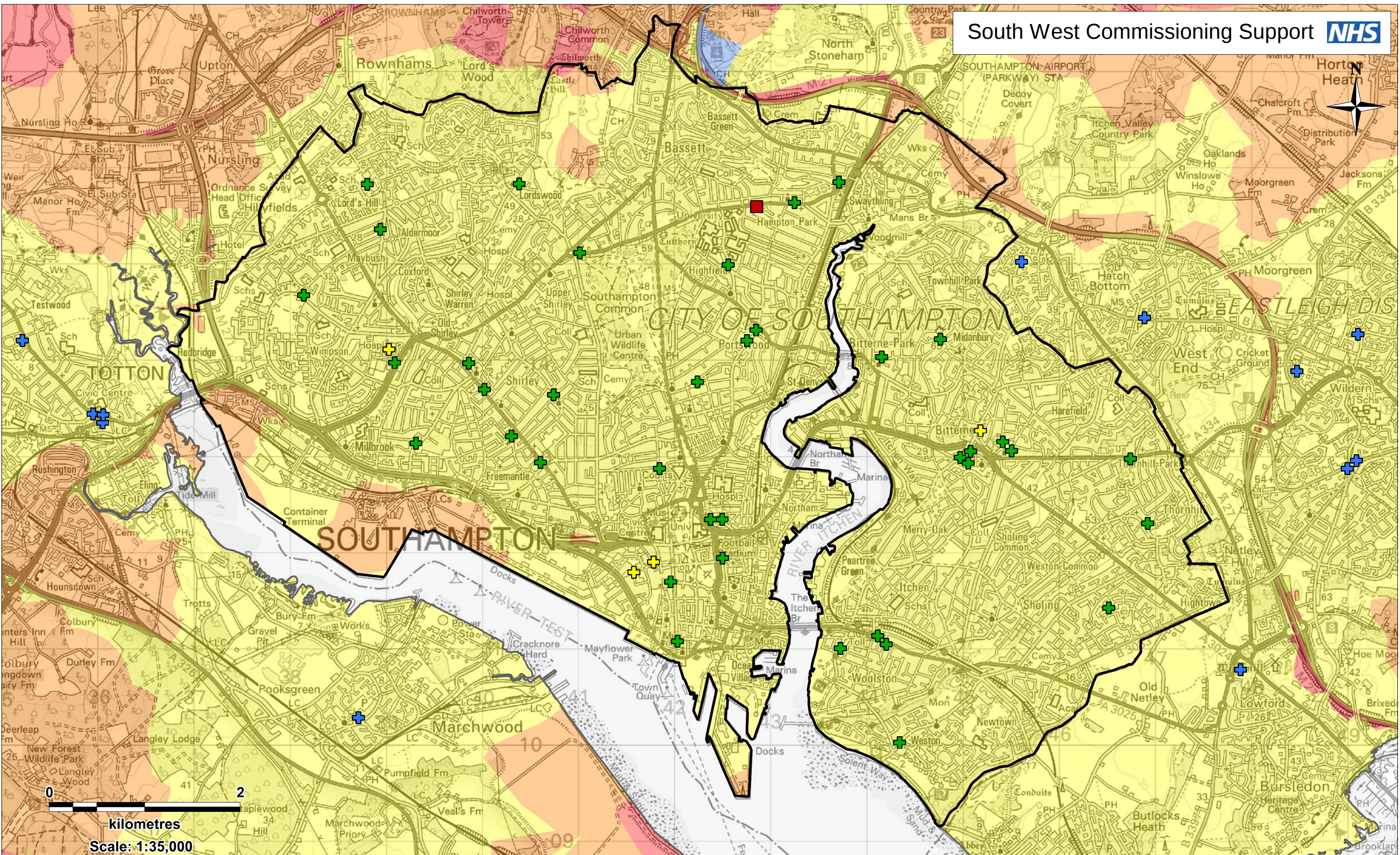

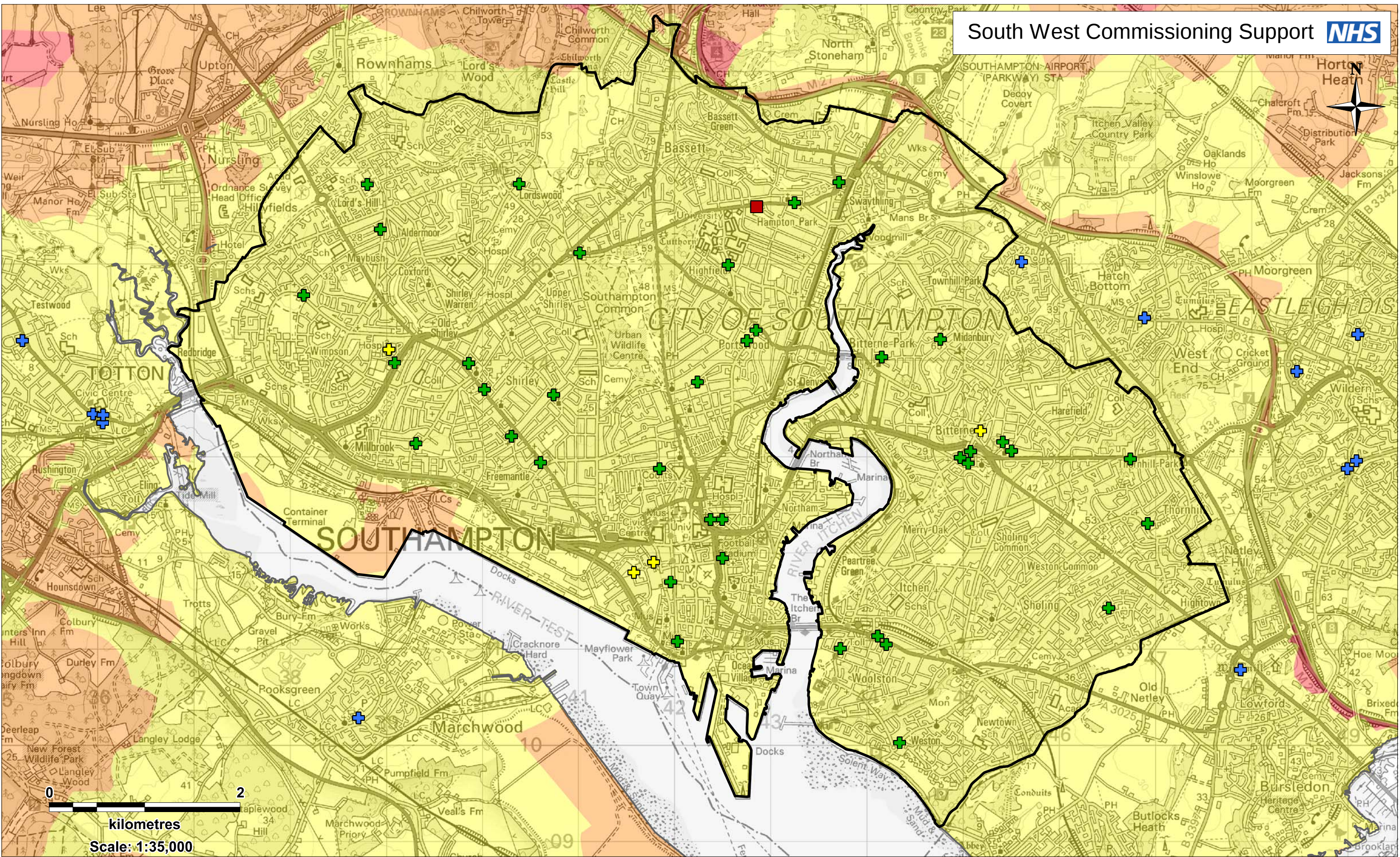

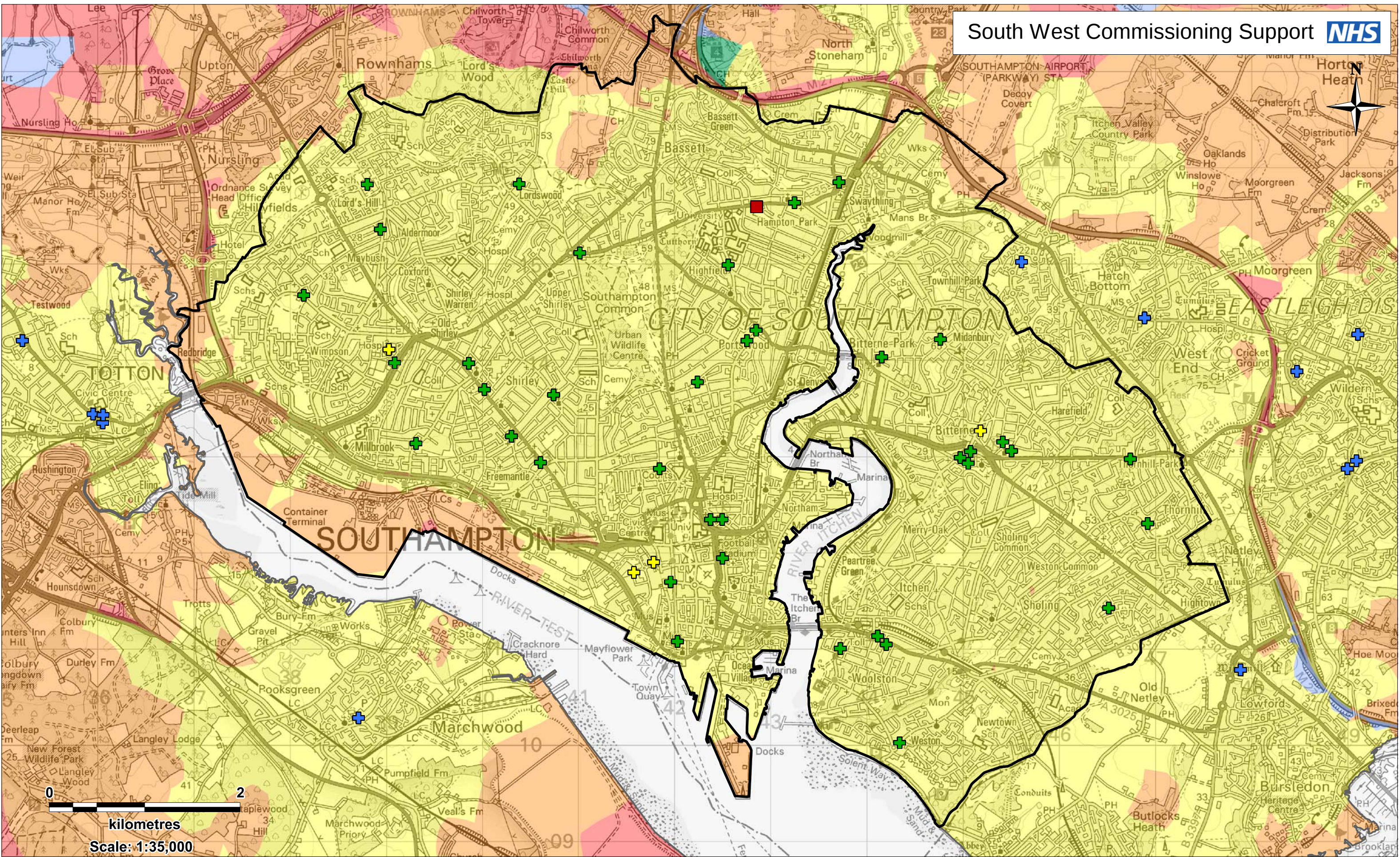

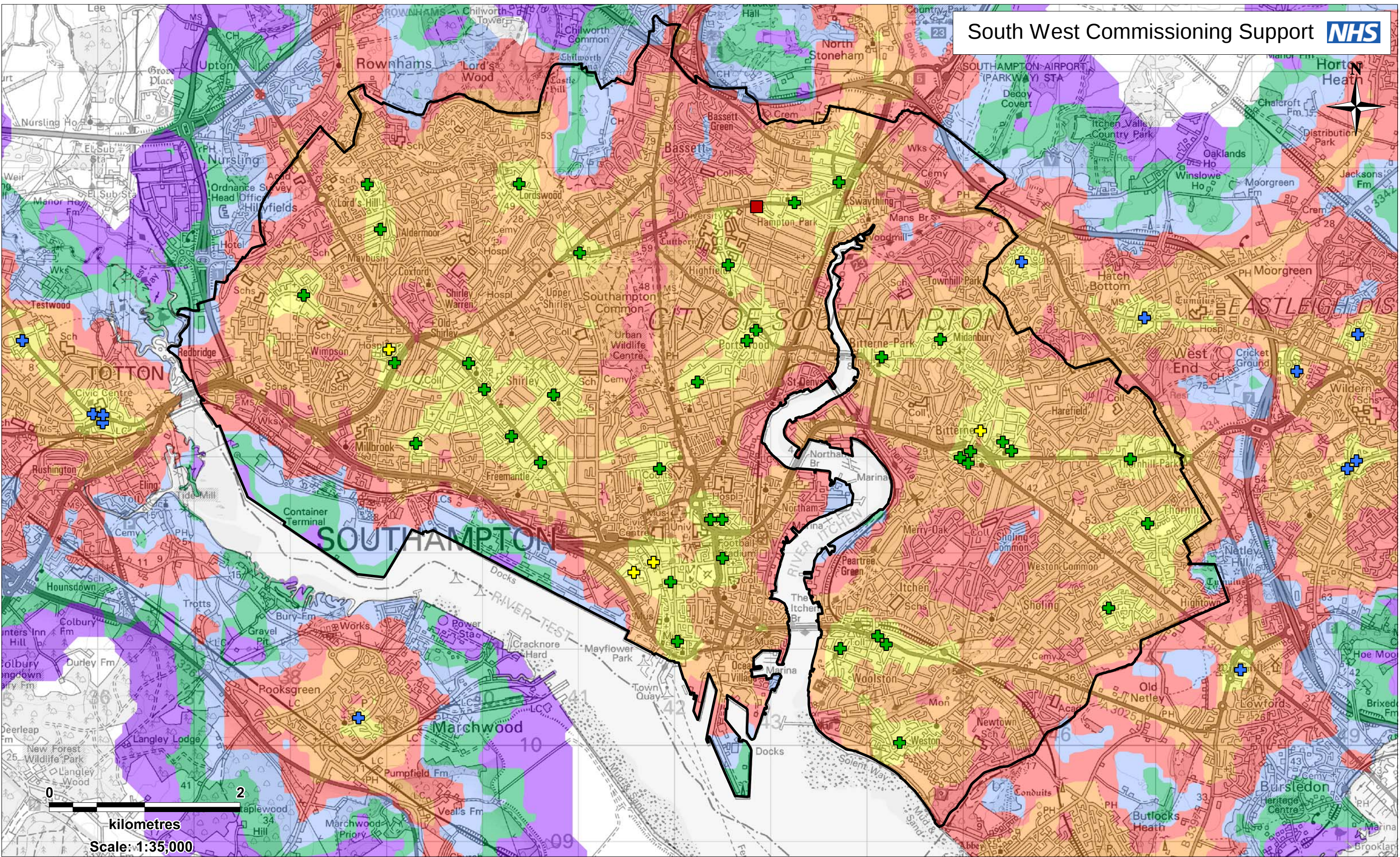

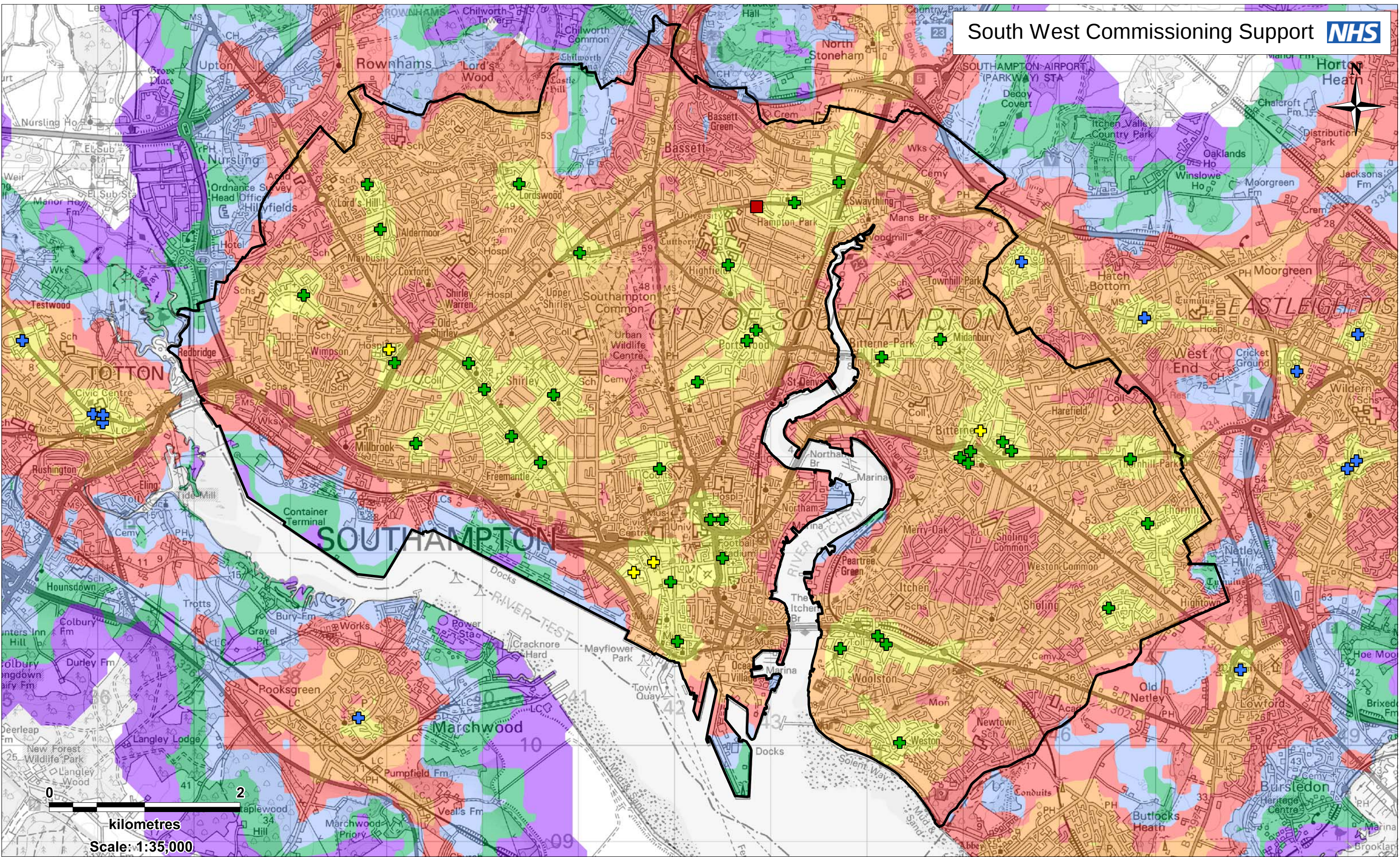

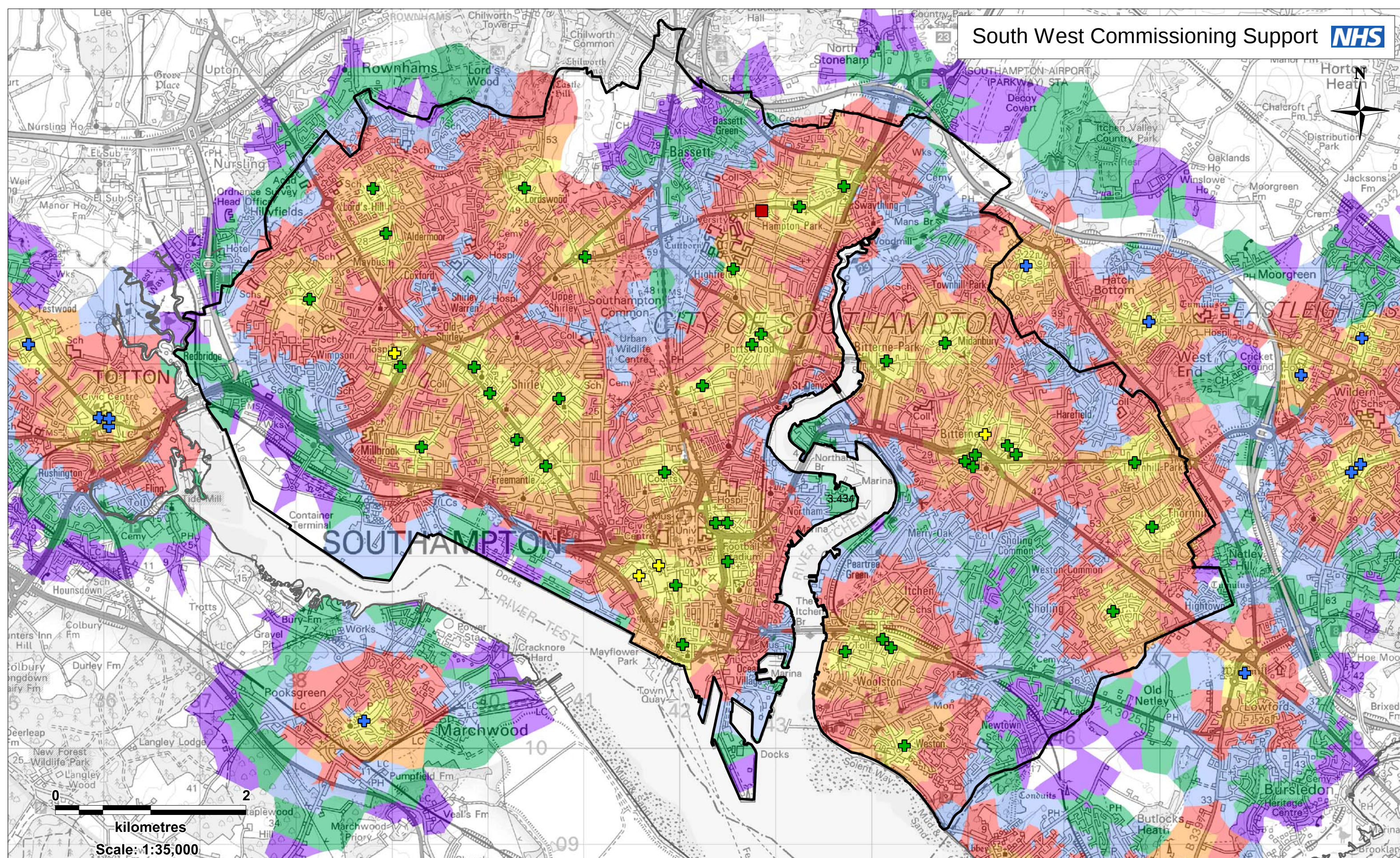

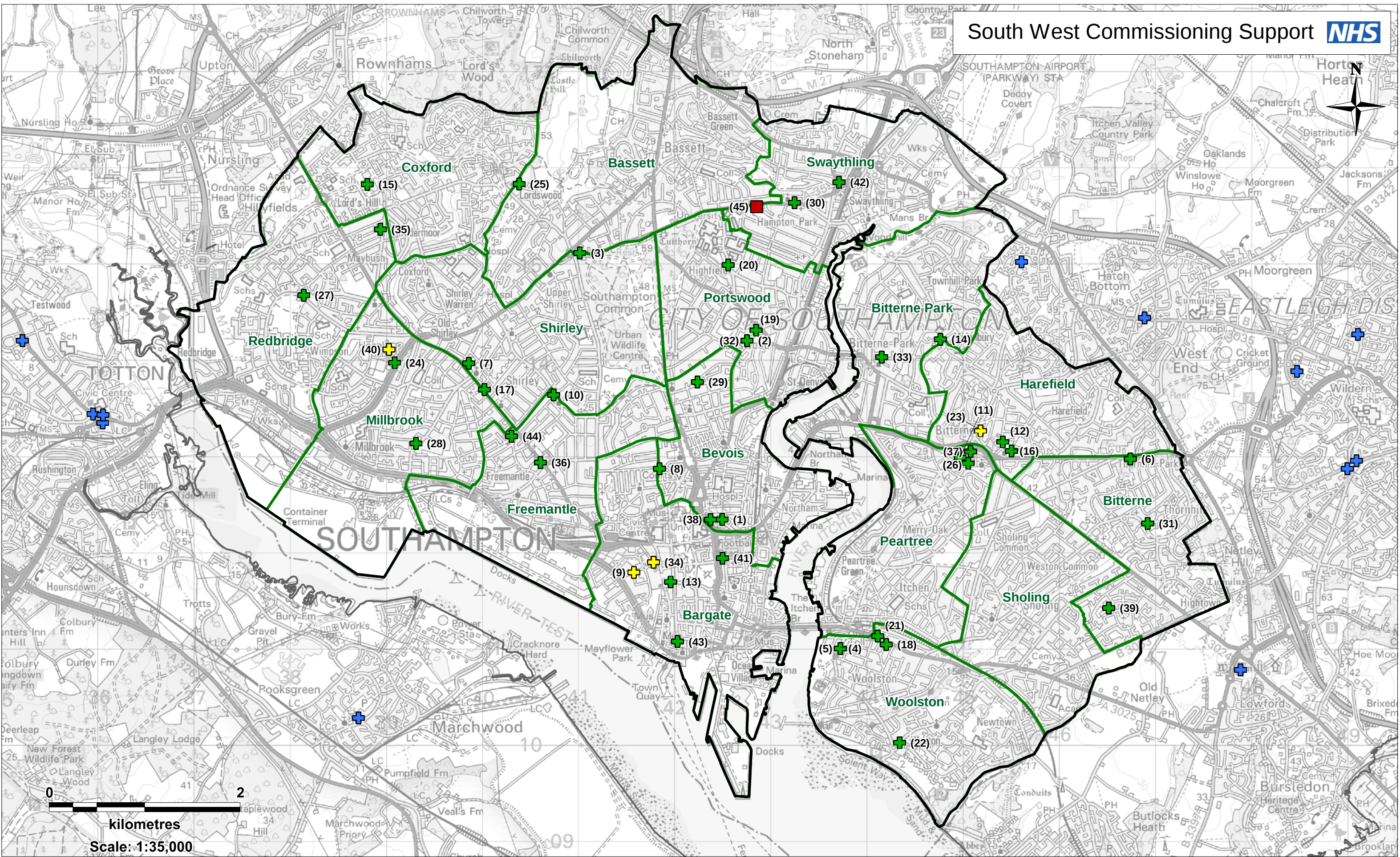
