

Southampton Child Friendly Cities Insights and Data Pack Culture Badge Summary – 2022

Southampton City Council – Data, Intelligence & Insight Team





The main aim of the Child Friendly Southampton discovery stage was to collate both intelligence and insight across the city to provide a wider view of the children and young people in Southampton, and how they feel about a variety of topics.

This engagement activity ran through Summer 2022.

The main route for feedback was our Child Friendly Southampton Baseline Survey, which was circulated across the city with a main version as well as an easy read version for SEND and early years. We also created some activities to get feedback on certain topics in the questionnaire. The surveys and activities were promoted in the following ways:

- Roadshow
- Youth groups
- Local Events (e.g. Mela Festival and SPCA Play Day)
- Social Media
- Education settings
- Digital posters
- E-bulletins
- On the website
- Emails to stakeholders and partners
- Focus Groups

We also asked and collated questions from other surveys to that ran across the city including:

- Children and Young People's Draft Strategy Consultation (a younger version of the questionnaire was circulated to children and young people across the city at the end of 2021)
- Make your Mark (a poll and a questionnaire was circulated to children and young people across the city in Spring 2022)
- School Streets Survey (a survey that was conducted at selected schools in Summer 2022)

This report also outlines some of the key data intelligence figures around children and young people in the city on a variety of topics including safety, health, place and education.






About the respondents





In total, we had 1338 responses from our Child Friendly Baseline Survey and Activities.

We asked these respondents a variety of demographic and profiling questions to ensure that there was a broad representation of children and young telling us their thoughts and views, and to understand how different children and young people feel across the city.



For the culture badge, we spoke to young people about their rights and things to do across the city. We found out that:


- The majority of children and young people we surveyed know what children's rights are.
- They mostly found out about their rights at school, compared to anywhere else.
- 1 in 10 respondents disagreed that children and young people have rights in Southampton.
- Respondents from minority ethnic and younger age groups selected that they know what children's rights were more, and that they had learnt about them more,
 compared to white ethnicities and older age groups.
- When it comes to activities taken part in, survey respondents said they spend their time with family more than any other activity listed.
- The activity that respondents selected they do the least was taking part in community groups and volunteering and attending youth clubs.
- Although community groups and volunteering was one of the least done activities across the city, almost half of respondents selected that they would like to do this.
- Although respondents told us that going online and watching TV was their second most done activity in the city, just over a quarter of respondents said that there was too much of this.
- The activity respondents selected that they were least interested in taking part in was faith based worship.
- Children and young people told us in free-text comments that the reason they don't partake in activities that they want to is because of the lack of opportunities and information available.
- Where asked if there was enough to do in the city, male respondents selected that there was either the right amount or too much for every activity, compared to females who had selected 'not enough' more.
- Where asked if there was enough to do in the city, trips out and music and performance scored the highest in the 'not enough' category.
- When asked where they feel most welcome, children and young people selected that they feel most welcome when spending time with family, and least welcome at youth clubs.
